DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

ADVANCED ENTRIES ONLY - FIRST RECEIVED - LIMIT 15 DOGS PER EVENT

These trials are open to All Breeds and Canine Partner Registered Dogs. This trial is open to all dogs TWELVE (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: Dog of any breed who are at least 12 months of age that are registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the Canine Partners program. Bitches in season may enter, but must wear pants. Dogs with disabilities may participate in the ATT test. However, if a dog has multiple disabilities (e.g. blind and deaf), such that it is unable to perform whole categories of the test (such as hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), the dog would not earn the ATT title.

TESTING TIME AND CHECK-IN TIME: Approximately 6 dogs can be tested in an hour, your testing time and check in time will be assigned according to when entries arrive or are received by the trial secretary. You will be notified by the secretary of your testing/check in time after the trial closes. Handlers **MUST** check-in the day they are scheduled to test.

TEST ENTRY FEES: Entry fee is \$30 per test.

Advanced entries will be accepted via mail only. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Direct inquiries to Kaaren Koroly at kaaren@treasurecoastkennelclub.org Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

If you enter two tests, after the first test, the second test will be approximately one hour apart. Dogs will be run through test 1 with the first evaluator, and will run test 2 with the second evaluator (approximately one hour time between the two tests).

Day-of entries will NOT be accepted.

A dog may enter only once per test, and one test is defined as one event number.

Entries are first received. Once entry limits are reached, all other entries will go onto a wait list.

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this test. Exhibitors should review all testing information found at www.akc.org/akctemptest/ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Treasure Coast Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Treasure Coast Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Treasure Coast Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses

Slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, Martingales and body harnesses may be used in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather. Dogs must be on leash at all times. No retractable leashes on the grounds.

REFUNDS There will be no refunds unless approved by the event committee.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Testing will be outside, under cover. You may kennel your dog on the premises while waiting your turn to test. Dogs must be crated away from the test area, as not to become desensitized to the audible portions of the test. Please ensure your dog is comfortable and has water available.

Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST TITLE

If a dog passes the ATT on two occasions, under two different judges, the owner may apply for the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) suffix title by going online to www.akc.org/akctempstest and submitting the ATT title application along with the Evaluator Score Sheets (one from each of the two required tests) and the required title application fee. Upon verification, the ATT title will be applied to the dog's record and will appear on the dog's AKC title record. The title certificate will be mailed to the dog's primary owner of record.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST BASICS

Breed Temperament Information: One purpose of the ATT is to educate dog owners about the temperament of their breeds. At each test, in addition to a title application form and their contact information on the test checklist, handlers must complete the form labeled, "YOUR BREED'S TEMPERAMENT." The form includes a space for the handlers of mixed breed dogs to write about the temperament of their individual dogs. AKC Resources (see below) are the source required for breed specific temperament characteristics for owners. Owners must complete the YOUR BREED form noted. Blank forms may be downloaded from AKC resources (suggested) or may be obtained at the test site on the day of the test.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST STATIONS (& EQUIPMENT)

- **SOCIAL** – Computer bag, chair in bag on arm, large purse, etc.
- **AUDITORY** – Large plastic bottle (1-gallon milk jug) w/coins, handheld vacuum cleaner, whistle, bike horn
- **VISUAL** – Umbrella, Roller bag, wagon, crate dolly or cooler on wheels, flapping and towel
- **TACTILE** – Wire grate (ex-pen), plastic tarp, plastic lattice & memory foam, peg board & air mattress
- **PROPRIOCEPTIVE** (motion) – PVC ladder/low bars/hurdles, hoops (8), low teeter, low platform
- **UNEXPECTED STIMULUS** – Large box, large stuffed animal/doll, folding/collapsible chair in bag, walker, wheelchair/crutches, selection of unusual clothing

ADDITIONAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Repeating a Test Item: Dogs may not repeat test items in these categories: Social, Auditory, Visual and Unexpected Stimulus. Dogs may attempt test items a total of 3 times for the Tactile and Proprioceptive categories. Scores are adjusted accordingly when test items are repeated.

Spectator/Crating Space: You may kennel your dog under the cover. If you will be using a kennel, please ask an Evaluator or club member where to position your kennel. Dogs must be crated away from the test area, as not to become desensitized to the audible portions of the test. Please ensure your dog is comfortable and has water available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

Collars: Dogs may wear Slip Collars (on dead ring), Martingales, or Body Harnesses. Dogs may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the dog's movement. FLEXI-LEADS are NOT ALLOWED anywhere on the property.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
